## How Using UTRAC Competence Validation Alleviates Regulatory Non-Compliance

Establishing and sustaining a workplace OHS&E strategy entails regulatory compliance management for each job including:

- The identification of hazards
- The development of safe working policies and practices
- The delivery of training relative to these policies and practices
- The testing and review of individuals relative to these policies and practices
- A process to manage and report the observance of these policies and practices

World ICU and its UTRAC competency validation system support managing regulatory compliance through:

- The development of job-specific competencies through which the job-specific hazards can be identified
- The development of job profiles that serve as documentation for safe working policies and practices
- The identification and support of specific training requirements for filling identified gaps
- The insistence of the validation of competencies with a qualified Validator as the basis for meeting policy standards
- A system to manage the practices and ensure the compliance strategies are implemented
